



AICP Timeline



1986: Principles include a provision that the society would meet quarterly, the formal meetings would occur during NAIC Summer and Winter Annual Meetings, and informal discussion groups would meet during the Spring & Fall NAIC meetings. At this time, membership was only open to P&C industry personnel, and there were no dues.



1987: a) The SSF has grown to 232 members, representing 159 insurers; b) The following committees are formed: Education, Planning, Executive, Personal Lines & Commercial Lines Liaison Committees; c) 6/4/87— Meeting held in Chicago; d) the SSF announced it would be a clearing house for state filings employment opportunities; e) Jan Shemanske, Chair NAIC Personal Lines Liaison Committee, and Bob Lennon, Chair NAIC Commercial Lines Liaison Committee, met with NAIC Commissioner Bergeron to initiate channels of communication; f) the SSF announced it's planning its first stand-alone meeting to be held in Chicago in October, 1988



1991: 5/17/91-Organizational meeting with 14 attendees for the MINK (Missouri, Iowa, Nebraska, & Kansas), later named Heartland Chapter.
